Biography

Evangelist Sam Austin is an ordained Assemblies of God minister with a Pentecostal Heritage. His grandfather donated the land upon which an Assembly of God Church was built in 1923 in Pope County Arkansas. It was in that church where he grew up. His Dad taught the same Sunday School class in that church for 60 years. Upon completion of High School Sam married his wife, Bobbye, in 1965. They were saved in 1972. He began preaching in the spring of 1973 and entered full time ministry in January of 1975. He has pastored three church, First Assembly of God in Ashdown Arkansas, Happy Valley Assembly of God near Russellville, Arkansas and for nine years he pastored First Assembly of God in Milan, Tennessee. While pastoring in Tennessee he served on the Tennessee District Board for over 7 years. In 1994 he resigned his pastorate in Milan to return to full time evangelistic work. He and his wife have four beautiful daughters, four terrific sons in law and 7 wonderful grandchildren.
